Vision

Introduction

Objectives

Types of projects / work that the Trust could support:

- Supporting the ministry of St Botolph's Church, excluding maintenance and running costs.
- Children's and youth work at St Botolph's Church.
- Evangelical outreach, primarily within the local community.
- Hanwood Park church plant – support until financially self-sufficient.
- Roles involved in gospel ministry in the community.
- Discipleship, mentoring, training and equipping God's people in all aspects of gospel ministry.



Church Plant

As Barton Seagrave continues to expand, specifically through the Hanwood Park development, the intention is to plant a new church. The Trust sees this as a great opportunity that fits well with its vision, enabling the church to be at the heart of the community, being a light to all, drawing people to faith, encouraging growth, offering love and support, and meeting the needs of the local community. The Trust would aim to provide financial support for resources to set up and run the church, including building, clergy and worker wages, etc.

Community

Supporting work with children, young people, and families by teaching the Bible faithfully, preparing them to navigate the challenges of life, and bringing them to know Jesus and grow in faith.

Outreach projects into the community, understanding their needs and how the church can meet their needs.

Finance

St Botolph's PCC has previously allocated a portion of its Parish Share to The Standfast Trust, enabling the Trust to pursue its mission of sharing the Gospel message in Barton Seagrave. The Trust remains committed to ensuring that all funding is used faithfully and in line with its stated purpose, and will continue to work closely with the clergy, wardens, and PCC of St Botolph's to support this shared ministry. The Trust is Gift Aid registered.
